# AMO and the Federal Gas Tax Fund can help

Between 2014 and 2016, local governments used the Fund to...

Install nearly 27,000 energy-efficient streetlights

Purchase, replace or refurbish over 650 public transit vehicles

Distribute over 25,000 new blue boxes or green bins

Rehabilitate over 9,000 lane-km of local roads



Replace or rehabilitate over 100 km of pipes and sewers



# The information that you share speaks volumes

Between 2014 and 2016, communities invested \$7.5 million to install 15,601 energy-efficient LED street lights, saving 6.62 GWh in annual energy consumption – enough to power over 700 houses for a year.
