You also act as the principle planning advisor and spokesperson for the corporation before Planning Committee, City Council and other Committees and Boards on planning matters, and represents the Division on other local or provincial general or special purpose committees as well as before the general public on planning services related issues.

You must have a University degree in Planning or a related discipline from a recognized University and be a registered Ontario Professional Planner and full membership in the Ontario Professional Planners Institute. You have a minimum of ten years directly related planning and development experience at a senior management level in a large unionized, and highly diversified public or private sector organization, including years managing a similar function. You possess knowledge of horizontal linkage to other relevant government agencies and services (particularly Ontario Ministries of Municipal Affairs and Housing, Natural Resources, Environment, Transportation, Northern Development and Mines and Agriculture), as well as the private sector. You also have knowledge of current and emerging management issues within the City of Greater Sudbury as they affect the Planning Services Division.

You will set yourself apart for your peers if you have a high customer service focus by working closely with internal and external customers to meet and exceed their expectations. You understand the business implications of opportunities and decisions, and implement successful business strategies to improve organizational performance.
