<u>Scenario</u>

Level(s) Involved <u>Teacher Notes / Key Concepts</u>

1. Transit line project	Municipal, Provincial, Federal	Cities run transit systems; provincial and federal governments often fund large projects tied to climate or economy.
2. Tornado alert failure	Federal, Provincial, Municipal	Federal alert system, provincial emergency management, municipal responders — all play roles in public safety.
3. Tree-planting bylaw	Municipal, Provincial	Municipal environmental bylaws may be limited by provincial property legislation.
4. Gun law not enforced	Federal, Provincial	Federal sets gun laws; provinces may refuse enforcement (e.g., handgun buyback opt-outs).
5. Wildfire response	Municipal, Provincial, Federal	Evacuation = local; coordination = provincial; recovery aid = federal.
6. TikTok misinformation	Federal, Provincial	Health is provincial; content regulation is federal (e.g., Health Canada or Bill C-11).
7. Rural broadband access	Federal, Provincial, Municipal	Federal and provincial infrastructure grants; local governments help with access and planning.



8. Indigenous health centre	Federal, Provincial, Indigenous	Federal funds Indigenous health; provincial standards apply; self-government under reconciliation.
9. Stadium project funding	Federal, Provincial, Municipal	Federal grants, provincial tourism, municipal permits/zoning.
10. City sales tax proposal	Provincial, Municipal	Cities can't levy sales tax without provincial approval.
11. Affordable housing	Municipal, Provincial, Federal	Cities manage zoning; provinces run housing agencies; federal supports via CMHC.
12. Climate agreement	Federal, Provincial, Municipal	Federal signs agreements; provinces regulate emissions; cities implement local plans.
13. Curriculum dispute	Provincial	Education is provincial; unions advocate but aren't part of government.
14. E. coli outbreak	Federal, Provincial	Federal CFIA ensures food safety; provincial health units manage response.
15. Youth criminal charge	Federal, Provincial	Federal sets youth justice laws; provinces handle courts and programs.
16. Plastics ban	Federal, Provincial, Municipal	Federal sets regulation; municipalities enforce; provinces may supplement rules.



17. Street renaming	Municipal	Handled by city councils; may involve consultation or heritage review.
18. New highway	Provincial, Federal (possibly Municipal)	Highways are provincial; federal funds national trade routes; cities involved in local impacts.
19. Cyberattack response	Provincial, Federal	Federal manages infrastructure protection; provinces oversee affected institutions.
20. Mental health outreach	Provincial, Federal, Municipal	Provincial healthcare systems, federal grants, municipal service partnerships.
