- 5. Implement Measures to Curtail the Financialization of Rental Housing Markets
- 6. Distinct Housing Strategy for Indigenous Peoples
- 7. Implement a Right to Housing Legislation and Structure
- 8. Make Renting more Secure and Affordable
- Prevention Based Approach to Ending Homelessness
- 10. Additional Funding and Supports for Rural and Remote Communities
