A university degree in public administration, public policy, economics, political science, social sciences, planning, or related discipline is preferred. Statistical and analytical skills, knowledge of municipal government, superior written and verbal communications and effective client relations will benefit applicants. Preference will be given to students who have an academic requirement for an internship placement.

The Internship is a temporary position of up to 17 weeks.

Remuneration is \$24 per hour for a 35-hour week.
